

A Request to the Residents in Nara Prefecture Based On the Recent Situation Involving COVID-19 in Nara


The following information shows the COVID-19 situation from July up until
November 8th.

After hitting its peak in mid August, the number of new cases remained low. However, since late October the number has been rising again.



Most primary cases are related to Osaka.

About 80 % of the primary cases



Related to Osaka: 162 people

- Infected when visiting Osaka: 152 people
- Infected by visitors from Osaka: 10 people


Infected when visiting places other than Osaka: 29 people

Infected by visitors from prefectures other than Osaka: 14 people

So far, no case has been reported of tourists from other prefectures being a source of infection.

(Translator's note: In this document, "primary cases" means Nara's residents who contracted the virus by visiting other prefectures + Nara's residents who contracted the virus by contacting visitors from other prefectures.)

Of the 372 patients including 205 primary cases and 167 cases under investigation, approximately 30% of people have passed the virus onto others (caused secondary cases) in Nara Prefecture.




Caused secondary cases in Nara:
106 people, 28%

Not caused secondary cases in Nara:
266 people, 72%

Spread of infection in Nara can be contained by reducing this 30%.

Of the secondary cases, 80% occurred within households, through extracurricular activities or living in dormitories, or during eating/drinking, or karaoke with friends.

A Request to the residents in Nara Prefecture

A. At home

➤ Stay in separate rooms from other family members **if you have cold-like symptoms, loss of sense of taste or smell, or have visited high-risk places in Osaka or other places recently.**

B. Extracurricular activities and dormitories

- If you have cold-like symptoms, or suspect you have been infected,
 - you should stop participating in activities.
 - please make sure that every dormitory resident has his/her own room.

C. Eating/drinking, karaoke with friends

➤ Please avoid gatherings if you have cold-like symptoms, or suspect you have been infected.
