Application


There are 2 ways to apply.

- ①Bring your student ID or something that identifies you as a student to the Nara **Prefecture International Citizens Support** Center.
- ②Go to your school's student support center and ask about applying.

You use the pass by showing it with your student ID at the reception desk at your destination.









Caution



- You are the only one allowed to use your pass, so do not lend it to anyone else.
- Please follow the institution's rules.
- The time and season you can use the pass changes depending on destination.
- The pass is valid until the validity period. After this period, you will need to apply for a new one.
- You cannot use the pass at Todai-ji temple.
