

- [1] Squirrels play an important role in nature. When squirrels gather nuts, they often bury them in the ground to eat later. However, they sometimes forget where they buried these nuts. Then, the buried nuts often get a chance to grow into trees. By just trying to keep their food, squirrels help new plants grow.
- [2] Ants are very small, but they are very important for nature, too. Some seeds have a tasty substance that ants really like. The ants are attracted to this substance and take the seeds back to their nests. They eat the substances and leave the rest of the seeds. Then, the seeds grow into plants. Ants work hard for their food, and it leads to helping plants grow.
- [3] Squirrels bury nuts and ants carry seeds to their nests. These are the behaviors that squirrels and ants have, and some plants can spread their seeds thanks to these behaviors. In this way, living things affect each other in nature.

A lot of people use trains to travel quickly and easily. However, trains are not just a way to travel quickly. Sometimes riding a train is the goal of people's trips. Actually, some train companies have suggested unique ways to make the experience on the train wonderful.

In Iwate, the Kotatsu Train is popular in winter. People can enjoy the ocean view and nice local meals in a *kotatsu* on the train. In Hakone, there is the Night Ajisai Train. During hydrangea season, people can enjoy lit-up hydrangeas along the tracks. In Niigata, there is a theater train called Yumezora. There are many tunnels in the area. When this train goes into tunnels, the ceiling becomes a big screen showing stars and fireworks. People can't see the view from the windows, but they can enjoy their time in tunnels.

These examples show that riding a train can be a special experience. Some trains are becoming more fun for people's trips.
