The Nara Prefectural Museum of Art will be holding its collection exhibition, "Come, See, Talk, and Explore an Art Museum" for this year's summer holiday period.

The artworks selected from our collection for this exhibition all have themes or motifs suitable for children and tailored to their level of development, and are organized around two main themes: "Let's find colors and shapes!" and "Let's make a story!" Also featured are exhibitions of works by children and young people. The exhibitions include a collaborative display of works from the Art Science Department of Osaka University of Arts and a joint exhibition of works by junior high school art clubs in Nara City, whose members participated in a national art competition titled *Art no Koshien*. Please take a moment to appreciate the various forms of artistic expression of our future artists.

This exhibition was designed to enrich children's artistic experiences. We hope that this exhibition will help visitors become more familiar with the Nara Prefectural Museum of Art, which we believe will help make our museum a comfortable place for everyone.
