

## Lesson1

Let's find the same colors and shapes!

Find the similarities between the two works. Pay attention to the “color” and “shape” of the works and observe every detail.

In this exhibition, visitors will learn “how to see pictures” using the Visual Thinking Strategy method. In the exhibition room, visitors can practice using this strategy across two themes: "Let's Find Colors and Shapes!" and "Let's Make Stories!".

First, let us focus on the “color” and “form” of the works in this exhibition room.

Step 1 Compare two works next to each other and look for the similarities between them.

Step 2 Describe the similarities in words.

For example, let's compare these two works. What do they have in common?

- They both have circles.
- They both have colors in common such as red, blue, and light blue.

By comparing two works of art, we can observe the details of each work and analyze the

impressions and feelings we receive from them from a “formative perspective” (i.e. in terms of color and composition). Please stand in front of each painting and look at each one carefully. Then, compare the two works next to each other and discover the characteristics of each piece.
